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1.0 CONSTRUCTION HISTORY AND SCHEDULE

1.1 CONSTRUCTION HISTORY

The Texas Water Commission granted permission to the City of Houston and TRA to initiate plans for the construction of the dam and reservoir in October 1960 and approved the co-owners plans and specifications in May 1966. The construction of the Livingston Dam Project commenced in 1966, and the project was certified as completed on September 4, 1969. Actual impoundment of water started in October 1968.

A large erosion control and scour prevention weir was constructed downstream of the stilling basin during 2001 and 2002. The overflow of the weir was constructed at elevation 63.0. The weir has effectively prevented the further degradation of the river channel just downstream from the existing stilling basin apron.

1.2 CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

A construction schedule in terms of months from the filing of the license is shown in *Figure C-1*.
